### CHILDREN'S PRICES

Children under 12 are admitted free when accompanied by adults who purchased tickets in **advance**. Otherwise it is \$2 per child at the gate. Kids 12 and over are full price.

#### TENT CAMPING & PARKING FEES

Tent camping is free for those holding (or purchasing) tickets for three or more consecutive days. Otherwise tent camping fees are \$5 per night per person. You must have festival tickets in order to camp on the ranch during the festival!

In order to maximize tent space in the campgrounds, transportation vehicles in the campgrounds are \$20 per day (refundable \$20 two-hour unloading permits will be issued at the gate). Parking is FREE in the parking meadow. No camping permitted in the parking meadow.

#### **RV SITES**

A limited number of RV hook-ups sites are available in the campgrounds. Sites with water/electricity/sewer are \$25 per night. Sites with water/electricity only (for small campers and pop-ups) are \$20 per night. RV site occupants can keep one tow vehicle on their pad at no additional charge. Reservations required. Restrictions may apply. Call (830) 257-3600 for info.

### **SLEEPER VEHICLES**

Obvious sleeper vehicles such as vans, pick-ups with camper shells, etc. will be charged a single \$20 fee upon entry. If the vehicle doesn't leave the campground, no additional camping fees will be required. \$20 will be charged for **EACH** re-entry to the campgrounds.
